- We trained 2600 ASHA Worker, ANM/LHV on ASHA Module 6-7 Training. Training of health worker about main national diseases, MMR&IMR reduction, cent percent immunization of child and pregnant women, emergency health facilities in remote villages, we trained about examination, registration and documentation With Support from National Health Mission MP.
- Under Adolescent health program we undertake menstrual hygiene management (MHM) in Dhar district of M.P. Training of Adolescent Girls and Women's under ARSH Program with support from NHM MP.
- Awareness creation and Training with more than 30 self Help Groups on issue of Menstrual Hygiene Management CASA and Action Aid Supported program.
- Anemia is a severe problem among women in India, specifically in Madhya Pradesh (MP). At the behest of Government of MP (GoMP), Nutrition International with the help of Vasudha Vikas Sansthan is supporting the roll out of Double Fortified Salt program in the selected 5 districts via Dhar, Jhabua, Alirajpur, Badwani and Khargone since August 2017.
