All the above stated interventions have led to establishing linkages with different resource agencies both government and non-governmental for the purpose of capacity building, resources mobilization, experience sharing etc. These partnerships based programmes promoted collective actions in influencing entritlement based policies and also develop alternative means for sustainable development.
